Paper Submission

Paper submissions will be reviewed and evaluated based on originality, technical quality, and relevance to conference. Submission of papers will be carried out electronically via the Web in PDF format. Papers should not exceed ten pages, and follow ACM SIG guidelines: http://www.acm.org/sigs/pubs/proceed/template.html. We plan to have the proceedings published through ACM and have it available in ACM Digital library. There are also plans to bring out a special issue in some journal of repute.
